#### Turn On Your Remote

1 Remove the *PULL* tab on the back of your remote control



2 Press SYSTEM INFO on your receiver



The appearance and location of the SYSTEM INFO button varies from receiver to receiver

This button is located behind a door on the front of some receivers

3 Press SAT and then RECORD on your remote






4 Select Done on the screen



#### Pair Your Remote

1 Press and hold the device button you want to program until all four device buttons light up



Press and hold

- · TV to pair with your TV
- · DVD or AUX to pair with any other device
- 2 Enter the three-digit code for your device while the device buttons are lit up

3 Press #



The device button you selected will flash three times

4 Press the device power button





Your device will turn on or off
